

Ninth lesson – asking for your room key

Now that we've got the numbers clear..., let's learn how to ask for your room key at reception:

English: Room 201 , please

Greek: Το κλειδί διακόσια ένα, παρακαλώ. (to klithie thiakosya ena, parakalo)

To be accurate, "Το κλειδί" (klithie) means "the key", as this is the expression we use in Greek.

To be even more advanced, one would also say:

English: may I have room key 201 , please?

Greek: Μπορώ να έχω το κλειδί διακόσια ένα, παρακαλώ? (mporo na eho to klithie thiakosya ena, parakalo)
